

## **2018 Set Subject Definitions**

(All photos may be colour or Black and White unless otherwise stated).

### ***January 2018: Food***

An image that depicts the preparation and/or presentation of food for human consumption

### ***February 2018: Still Life***

The depiction of inanimate subject matter, typically a small group of objects. It is the application of photography to the still life artistic style.

### ***March 2018: Pets and Animals (Domestic)***

A photograph of one or more domestic animals.

### ***April 2018: Boats***

A photograph of one or more boats either in action or at anchor/mooring

### ***May 2018: Speed It Up***

An image taken with a shutter speed of 1/500<sup>th</sup> of a second or greater, that shows movement frozen by the speed of the shutter.

### ***June 2018: Architecture***

An aesthetically pleasing and accurate representation of a building or similar subject.

### ***July 2018: Abstract***

A visual image that does not have an immediate association with the object world and that has been created through the use of photographic equipment, processes or materials.

### ***August 2018: Cultural Identity***

An image that tells a story of the cultural identity of a place or time.

### ***September 2018: Flora***

May include garden plants but should not include cut flowers, wreaths, bouquet or vases.

### ***October 2018: Agriculture / Aquaculture***

A photo-journalistic image that depicts agricultural or aquaculture activities.

### ***November 2018: Low Light***

An image taken at low light requiring a shutter speed of 1/50<sup>th</sup> of a second or longer. May include night sky photography or light painting.

### ***December 2018: Technology***

An image that shows the collection of techniques, skills, equipment or processes in the production of goods or services or the achievement of outcomes.

## **2018 Special Subject Definitions**

(All photos in the "Special Subjects" can be any size as long they fit on an A4/8 x12 sheet)

### ***March 2018: People***

May include 1 or more persons . Portraiture, Child Study or Group of People.

### ***June 2018: Landscape***

Buildings should not dominate.

### ***September 2018: Creative / Experimental***

Digital or darkroom..

### ***December 2018: Monochrome***

Photographs in the shade of a single colour.
