

# "Nature of Eyre"

A photo competition hosted by the Port Lincoln Camera Club to promote the Nature of Eyre - Natural History Conference to be held in Coffin Bay 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> September 2017.

The competition consists of 2 categories  
The **Macro World of Invertebrates** and **Natural History of Eyre Peninsula**

The **Macro World of Invertebrates** category has been chosen to emphasise the important ecological role insects play in our environment. The dominant subject of the photo must be a native invertebrate of Eyre Peninsula and may be macro or "close up" with a strong depth of field.

The **Natural History of Eyre Peninsula** is a relatively open category to celebrate the natural history of Eyre Peninsula. Photos to be taken on Eyre Peninsula (including Gawler Ranges) and surrounding waters with dominant subject to be Native Flora, Fauna or Geology (Landscape / Seascape).

Drop entries off to Lincoln Camera Centre or to your EPCCA representative. An A4 or 12"x 8" print mounted on black or white card (details below) and a 6x4" print must be submitted with each entry.

Cost is \$5 per entry with a limit of 2 entries per person.

1. All entries **must** be original work of the entrant.
2. No more than 2 entries per person (2 in the same category or 1 in each)
3. A 4" x 6" print is to be submitted with the enlargement. A collage will be made during the conference.
4. Enlargements must be mounted on matt board size 297mm x 355mm (with or without a back) with a cut out to suit 8" x 12" or A4 photos. Please place the title of the photo on the front bottom left and name and address details on the **back** of the mount.
5. Digital copies will be required from the finalists.
6. Entries close 1<sup>st</sup> September 2017 and must be delivered to Lincoln Camera Centre or to your local EPCCA rep.
7. Entrants agree to allow reproduction of their work for promotional purposes.
